## A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Transportation to conduct a test to determine the costs and benefits of requiring jetpropelled aircraft taking off from Newark International Airport, New Jersey, to conduct ascents over the ocean, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. TEST OF AIRCRAFT OCEAN ROUTING.
- 4 In order to examine an option for reducing aircraft
- 5 noise over communities in New Jersey, the Secretary of
- 6 Transportation shall conduct a 6-month live test to deter-
- 7 mine the costs and benefits of requiring jet-propelled air-

- 1 craft to conduct ascents after taking off from Newark
- 2 International Airport, New Jersey, over the ocean. The
- 3 Secretary shall commence such test not later than 45 days
- 4 after the date of enactment of this Act.

#### 5 SEC. 2. REPORT.

- 6 Not later than 1 year after the date of enactment
- 7 of this Act, the Secretary of Transportation shall transmit
- 8 to Congress a report on the results of the test conducted
- 9 under section 1. The report shall include an analysis of
- 10 the effects on noise reduction of ocean routing of aircraft
- 11 taking off from Newark International Airport and any rec-
- 12 ommendations and comments of the Secretary concerning
- 13 ocean routing of air carrier aircraft taking off from New-
- 14 ark International Airport.

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
