Mr. PASCRELL introduced the following bill; which was referred to the
Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure

A BILL

To amend title 49, United States Code, to provide that motor carriers safety permits for the transportation of hazardous material be subject to annual renewal.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 That section 5109 of title 49, United States Code, is
4 amended—

5 (1) in subsection (c) by inserting “annual” be-
6 fore “application with”;

7 (2) in subsection (e)(2) by striking “duration,
8 terms,” and inserting “terms”;

1 (3) by redesignating subsection (h) as sub-
2 section (i); and

3 (4) by inserting after subsection (g) the follow-
4 ing:

5 “(h) DURATION.—A safety permit issued under this
6 section shall be effective for a period of 1 year.”.

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
