A BILL

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

- 3 SECTION 1. PROHIBITION OF USE ON DEPARTMENT OF DE-
- 4 FENSE FUNDS FOR DEPLOYMENT OF UNITED
- 5 STATES ARMED FORCES IN KOSOVO.
- 6 (a) In General.—None of the funds appropriated
- 7 or otherwise available to the Department of Defense may

- 1 be obligated or expended for the deployment of United
- 2 States Armed Forces in Kosovo.
- 3 (b) Exception.—The prohibition against the deploy-
- 4 ment of United States Armed Forces in Kosovo in sub-
- 5 section (a) shall not apply if such deployment is specifi-
- 6 cally authorized by a law enacted after the date of the
- 7 enactment of this Act.
