## A BILL

To limit further production of the Trident II (D-5) missile.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Trident II (D-5) Mis-  
5       sile Production Limitation Act”.

6       **SEC. 2. DISCONTINUATION OF PRODUCTION OF NEW TRI-**  
7       **DENT II (D-5) MISSILES.**

8       (a) PRODUCTION LIMITATION.—Funds appropriated  
9       for the Department of Defense for fiscal years after fiscal  
10      year 1999 may not be obligated or expended to commence  
11      production of additional Trident II (D-5) missiles.

1       (b) AUTHORIZED SCOPE OF TRIDENT II (D-5) PRO-  
2 GRAM.—Amounts appropriated for the Department of De-  
3 fense may be expended for the Trident II (D-5) missile  
4 program only for the completion of production of those  
5 Trident II (D-5) missiles which were commenced with  
6 funds appropriated for a fiscal year before fiscal year  
7 2000.
