- 8 (a) PRODUCTION LIMITATION.—Funds appropriated
 9 for the Department of Defense for fiscal years after fiscal
 10 year 1999 may not be obligated or expended to commence
 11 production of additional Trident II (D-5) missiles.

(b) AUTHORIZED SCOPE OF TRIDENT II (D-5) PRO GRAM.—Amounts appropriated for the Department of De fense may be expended for the Trident II (D-5) missile
 program only for the completion of production of those
 Trident II (D-5) missiles which were commenced with
 funds appropriated for a fiscal year before fiscal year
 2000.
