A BILL

To amend the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971 to extend the deadline for the submission to the Federal Election Commission of campaign reports covering the first quarter of the calendar year.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION OF**
4 **FIRST QUARTER CAMPAIGN REPORTS TO**
5 **FEDERAL ELECTION COMMISSION.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 304(a) of the Federal
7 Election Campaign Act of 1971 (2 U.S.C. 434(a)) is
8 amended—

1 (1) in paragraph (2)(A)(iii), by inserting after
2 “except that” the following: “the report for the
3 quarter ending March 31 shall be filed no later than
4 May 1 and”;

5 (2) in paragraph (3)(B)(ii), by striking the pe-
6 riod at the end and inserting the following: “, except
7 that the report for the quarter ending March 31
8 shall be filed no later than May 1.”; and

9 (3) in paragraph (4)(A)(i), by inserting after
10 “except that” the following: “the report for the
11 quarter ending March 31 shall be filed no later than
12 May 1 and”.

13 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
14 subsection (a) shall apply with respect to calendar quar-
15 ters beginning on or after January 1, 2000.
