Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
 SECTION 1. COMPENSATION FOR VACCINE-RELATED IN JURY.
 (a) WAIVER OF TIME LIMITATION.—The time limita-

6 tion set forth in section 2116(a)(1) of the Public Health
7 Service Act (42 U.S.C. 300aa-16(a)(1)) shall not apply
8 to a petition for compensation filed under section 2111
9 of that Act by Frank Redendo of Carmel, New York, for
10 injuries received as a result of a vaccine administered in
11 March of 1964.

(b) DEADLINE.—Subsection (a) shall apply only to
 a petition filed not later than 2 years after the date of
 the enactment of this Act.
