- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Home Page Tax Re-
- 5 peal Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. REPEAL.
- 7 (a) Repeal.—Section 8003 of the 1998 Supple-
- 8 mental Appropriations and Rescissions Act (112 Stat. 93)
- 9 is repealed.

- 1 (b) Effective Date.—The repeal made by sub-
- 2 section (a) shall be effective as of April 30, 1998.
- 3 SEC. 3. USE OF FUNDS.
- 4 The National Science Foundation may use funds ap-
- 5 propriated for fiscal year 1999 to meet any obligations re-
- 6 sulting from the enactment of this Act.
