AN ACT

For the relief of Nancy B. Wilson.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—For purposes of determining the 4 eligibility of Nancy B. Wilson, the wife of Alphonse M. 5 Wilson (Social Security No. 271–18–9548), to widow's insurance benefits under section 202(e) of the Social Secu-6 7 rity Act (42 U.S.C. 402(e)), Nancy B. Wilson shall be 8 deemed to have been married to Alphonse M. Wilson for 9 a period of not less than 9 months immediately prior to the day on which Alphonse M. Wilson died. 10

11 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—Subsection (a) takes effect12 on March 21, 1991.

(c) PAYMENT.—Any benefits to which Nancy B. Wilson is entitled for the period prior to the date of the enactment of this Act shall be paid to her in a lump sum.
