- 4 (a) In General.—Section 41 of the Internal Reve-
- 5 nue Code of 1986 (relating to credit for increasing re-
- 6 search activities) is amended by striking subsection (h).
- 7 (b) Conforming Amendment.—Paragraph (1) of
- 8 section 45C(b) of such Code is amended by striking sub-
- 9 paragraph (D).

- 1 (c) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
- 2 this section shall apply to amounts paid or incurred after

3 June 30, 1999.
