## A BILL

To amend the National Labor Relations Act to ensure that the National Labor Relations Board does not decline to assert jurisdiction over the horseracing and dogracing industries.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. BOARD JURISDICTION.**

4 Section 14 of the National Labor Relations Act (29  
5 U.S.C. 164) is amended by adding at the end the follow-  
6 ing:

7 “(d) Notwithstanding any rule or regulation, the  
8 Board shall not decline to assert jurisdiction over any

- 1 labor dispute involving the horseracing and dogracing in-
- 2 dustries.”.
