- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Fairness for State and
- 5 Local Workers Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. COVERAGE OF STATE AND POLITICAL SUBDIVISION
- 7 EMPLOYEES.
- 8 Section 3(5) of the Occupational Safety and Health
- 9 Act of 1970 (29 U.S.C. 652(5)) is amended—

1	(1) by inserting after "employees," the follow-
2	ing: "including a State or political subdivision of a
3	State,"; and
4	(2) by striking "or any State or political sub-
5	division of a State".
