## A BILL

5	(a) In General.—Subsection (a) of section 923 of
6	the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (defining exempt for-
7	eign trade income) is amended by striking paragraph (5)
8	and by redesignating paragraph (6) as paragraph (5).
9	(b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
10	subsection (a) shall apply to taxable years beginning after
11	December 31, 1998.

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
