A BILL

For the relief of the estate of Irwin Rutman.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICER DESIGNATION.**

4 For purposes of part L of title I of the Omnibus
5 Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 (42 U.S.C.
6 3796 et seq.), relating to benefits for survivors of public
7 safety officers, Irwin Rutman of Staten Island, New York,
8 shall be deemed to have been a public safety officer on
9 October 29, 1990, and his family shall be entitled to death
10 benefits under such part.

1 **SEC. 2. LIMITATION OF ATTORNEYS' AND AGENTS' FEES.**

2 No amount exceeding 10 percent of a payment made
3 under section 1 may be paid to or received by any attorney
4 or agent for services rendered in connection with the pay-
5 ment. Any person who violates the provisions of this sec-
6 tion shall be guilty of an infraction and shall be subject
7 to a fine in the amount provided under title 18, United
8 States Code.
