## A BILL

To amend the Transportation Equity Act for the 21st Century to correct a high priority highway project for Ann Arbor, Michigan.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. CORRECTION OF HIGH PRIORITY PROJECT**

4               **FOR ANN ARBOR, MICHIGAN.**

5       Item 1135 of the table contained in section 1602 of  
6       the Transportation Equity Act for the 21st Century (112  
7       Stat. 298) is amended by striking “Replace Barton Road/  
8       M 14 interchange, Ann Arbor” and inserting “Conduct  
9       a study of all possible alternatives to the current M-14/  
10       Barton Drive interchange in Ann Arbor, including reloca-

tion on M-14/U.S. 23 from Maple Road to Plymouth  
Road, mass transit options, and other means of reducing  
commuter traffic and improving highway safety”.
