A BILL

For the relief of Rabon Lowry.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SATISFACTION OF CLAIM.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of the Treasury
5 shall pay, out of any money in the Treasury not otherwise
6 appropriated, to Rabon Lowry of Pembroke, North Caro-
7 lina, individually and as president of Pembroke Machine
8 Company, Inc., the sum of \$9,120,000 for damages he in-
9 curred as a result of the breach of Government Contract
10 number DAAA09–85–C–0630 by the United States De-
11 partment of the Army.

1 (b) CONDITION OF PAYMENT.—The payment shall be
2 in full satisfaction of any of claims Rabon Lowry may have
3 against the United States arising from Government Con-
4 tract number DAAA09–85–C–0630.

5 **SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON AGENTS AND ATTORNEYS FEES.**

6 It shall be unlawful for an amount that exceeds 10
7 percent of the sum described in section 1 to be paid to
8 or received by any agent or attorney for any service ren-
9 dered in connection with the benefits provided by this Act.
10 Any person who violates this section shall be guilty of an
11 infraction and shall be subject to a fine in the amount
12 provided in title 18, United States Code.
