A BILL

3 That, notwithstanding section 80001(c) of the Violent
4 Crime Control and Law Enforcement Act of 1994, section
5 3553(f) of title 18, United States Code, shall apply to all
6 sentences imposed before, on, or after September 13,
7 1994.
