3 **SECTION 1. REDESIGNATION OF CORONADO NATIONAL**
4 **FOREST, ARIZONA, IN HONOR OF MORRIS K.**
5 **UDALL.**

6 (a) REDESIGNATION.—The Coronado National For-
7 est in the State of Arizona is hereby redesignated as the
8 “Morris K. Udall National Forest” in honor of former
9 Representative Morris K. Udall.

1 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference to the Coronado
2 National Forest in any law, regulation, map, document,
3 record, or other paper of the United States shall be consid-
4 ered to be a reference to the Morris K. Udall National
5 Forest.
