RESOLUTION

Expressing support for a National Week of Reflection and
Tolerance.

Whereas America is a pluralistic country comprised of different races, genders, ethnic groups, religions, and creeds;

Whereas our Nation, founded on the principles of tolerance, diversity, justice, and equality, should affirm these common values and principles; and

Whereas Americans should reflect on the importance of understanding and tolerance in our pluralistic country:
Now, therefore, be it

- 1 *Resolved*, That a National Week of Reflection and
- 2 Tolerance should be established encouraging communities
- 3 and institutions around the Nation to engage in events

- 1 and activities that are reflective, educational, celebratory,
- 2 and healing as they relate to diversity among Americans.
