- 2 the House immediately shall consider the bill (H.R. 417)
- 3 to amend the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971 to
- 4 reform the financing of Federal elections. The first read-
- 5 ing of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points of order
- 6 against the bill and against its consideration are waived.
- 7 The bill shall be considered as read for amendment. The
- 8 bill shall be debatable for two hours equally divided and

- 1 controlled by Mr. Campbell and a member opposed to the
- 2 bill. The previous question shall be considered as ordered
- 3 on the bill to final passage without intervening motion ex-
- 4 cept one motion to recommit.
- 5 Sec. 2. It shall not be in order for the House to con-
- 6 sider a resolution which waives or supersedes any provi-
- 7 sion of this resolution.
