RESOLUTION

Fixing the daily hour of meeting of the First Session of
the One Hundred Sixth Congress.

1 *Resolved*, That unless otherwise ordered, before Mon-
2 day, May 10, 1999, the hour of daily meeting of the House
3 shall be 2 p.m. on Mondays; 11 a.m. on Tuesdays; and
4 10 a.m. on all other days of the week; and from Monday,
5 May 10, 1999, until the end of the second session, the
6 hour of daily meeting of the House shall be noon on Mon-
7 days; 10 a.m. on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays;
8 and 9 a.m. on all other days of the week.
