## **RESOLUTION**

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 515) to prevent children from injuring themselves with handguns.

- 1 Resolved, That immediately upon the adoption of this
- 2 resolution the House shall resolve itself into the Com-
- 3 mittee of the Whole House on the State of the Union for
- 4 consideration of the bill (H.R. 515) to prevent children
- 5 from injuring themselves with handguns. The first reading
- 6 of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points of order
- 7 against the bill and against its consideration are waived.
- 8 General debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not
- 9 exceed one hour equally divided and controlled by the
- 10 chairman and ranking minority member of the Committee

- 1 on Judiciary. After general debate the bill shall be consid-
- 2 ered for amendment under the five-minute rule for a pe-
- 3 riod not to exceed 10 hours and shall be considered as
- 4 read. At the conclusion of consideration of the bill for
- 5 amendment, the Committee shall rise and report the bill
- 6 to the House with such amendments as may have been
- 7 adopted. The previous question shall be considered as or-
- 8 dered on the bill and amendments thereto to final passage
- 9 without intervening motion, except one motion to recom-
- 10 mit with or without instructions.
