Ms. DEGETTE (for herself, Mr. BLAGOJEVICH, and Ms. CARSON) submitted  
the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Rules

## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 515) to prevent  
children from injuring themselves with handguns.

1       *Resolved*, That immediately upon the adoption of this  
2 resolution the House shall resolve itself into the Com-  
3 mittee of the Whole House on the State of the Union for  
4 consideration of the bill (H.R. 515) to prevent children  
5 from injuring themselves with handguns. The first reading  
6 of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points of order  
7 against the bill and against its consideration are waived.  
8 General debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not  
9 exceed one hour equally divided and controlled by the  
10 chairman and ranking minority member of the Committee

1 on Judiciary. After general debate the bill shall be consid-  
2 ered for amendment under the five-minute rule for a pe-  
3 riod not to exceed 10 hours and shall be considered as  
4 read. At the conclusion of consideration of the bill for  
5 amendment, the Committee shall rise and report the bill  
6 to the House with such amendments as may have been  
7 adopted. The previous question shall be considered as or-  
8 dered on the bill and amendments thereto to final passage  
9 without intervening motion, except one motion to recom-  
10 mit with or without instructions.
