Mr. REYNOLDS, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 434) to authorize a new trade and investment policy for sub-Sahara Africa.

- 1 Resolved, That, at any time after the adoption of this
- 2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
- 3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
- 4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
- 5 ation of the bill (H.R. 434) to authorize a new trade and
- 6 investment policy for sub-Sahara Africa. The first reading
- 7 of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points of order

against consideration of the bill are waived. General debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not exceed nine-3 ty minutes, with forty-five minutes equally divided and 4 controlled by the chairman and ranking minority member of the Committee on International Relations and forty-five minutes equally divided and controlled by the chairman 6 and ranking minority member of the Committee on Ways 8 and Means. After general debate the bill shall be considered for amendment under the five-minute rule. In lieu 10 of the amendments recommended by the Committees on International Relations and Ways and Means now printed in the bill, it shall be in order to consider as an original bill for the purpose of amendment under the five-minute rule an amendment in the nature of a substitute consisting 14 15 of the text of H.R. 2489. All points of order against that amendment in the nature of a substitute are waived. No 16 17 amendment to that amendment in the nature of a sub-18 stitute shall be in order except those printed in the report 19 of the Committee on Rules accompanying this resolution. 20 Each amendment may be offered only in the order printed 21 in the report, may be offered only by a Member designated in the report, shall be considered as read, shall be debat-23 able for the time specified in the report equally divided and controlled by the proponent and an opponent, shall not be subject to amendment, and shall not be subject to

- 1 a demand for division of the question in the House or in
- 2 the Committee of the Whole. All points of order against
- 3 the amendments printed in the report are waived. The
- 4 chairman of the Committee of the Whole may: (1) post-
- 5 pone until a time during further consideration in the Com-
- 6 mittee of the Whole a request for a recorded vote on any
- 7 amendment; and (2) reduce to five minutes the minimum
- 8 time for electronic voting on any postponed question that
- 9 follows another electronic vote without intervening busi-
- 10 ness, provided that the minimum time for electronic voting
- 11 on the first in any series of questions shall be 15 minutes.
- 12 At the conclusion of consideration of the bill for amend-
- 13 ment the Committee shall rise and report the bill to the
- 14 House with such amendments as may have been adopted.
- 15 Any Member may demand a separate vote in the House
- 16 on any amendment adopted in the Committee of the Whole
- 17 to the bill or to the amendment in the nature of a sub-
- 18 stitute made in order as original text. The previous ques-
- 19 tion shall be considered as ordered on the bill and amend-
- 20 ments thereto to final passage without intervening motion
- 21 except one motion to recommit with or without instruc-
- 22 tions.
