## RESOLUTION

1       *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution  
2 it shall be in order without intervention of any point of  
3 order to take from the Speaker's table the bill (S. 1467)  
4 to extend the funding levels for aviation programs for 60  
5 days, and to consider the Senate bill in the House. It shall  
6 be in order to move to strike all after the enacting clause  
7 of the Senate bill and to insert in lieu thereof the provi-  
8 sions of H.R. 1000 as passed by the House. All points

1 of order against that motion are waived. If the motion is  
2 adopted and the Senate bill, as amended, is passed, then  
3 it shall be in order to move that the House insist on its  
4 amendment to S. 1467 and request a conference with the  
5 Senate thereon.
