In the House of Representatives, U.S.,

Resolved,

1 SECTION 1. FINDINGS.

2 The House of Representatives finds the following:

3 (1) Hurricane Floyd made landfall on the coast
4 of North Carolina on September 15, 1999, as a cat5 egory two hurricane.

6 (2) In the State of North Carolina alone, the 7 hurricane caused the deaths of at least 50 individ-8 uals, damage to more than 40,000 homes, and bil-9 lions of dollars in infrastructure damage and agri-10 cultural losses.

(3) Citizens of the States of Florida, Georgia,
South Carolina, North Carolina, Virginia, Maryland,
Delaware, Pennsylvania, New Jersey, New York,
and Connecticut have registered for Federal disaster
relief aid as a result of Hurricane Floyd.

16 (4) More than six weeks after this disaster, the17 citizens of these States continue to await critical as-

sistance from the Federal Government to rebuild
 their homes, businesses, and lives.

3 SEC. 2. SENSE OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

4 It is the sense of the House of Representatives that 5 the President should immediately transmit to Congress 6 the President's recommendations for emergency response 7 actions, including appropriate offsets, to provide relief and 8 assistance to the victims of Hurricane Floyd.
