Mr. SHOWS submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Rules

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 664) to provide for substantial reductions in the price of prescription drugs for Medicare beneficiaries.

1 *Resolved*, That immediately after the adoption of this
2 resolution the House shall resolve into the Committee of
3 the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
4 ation of the bill (H.R. 664) to provide for substantial re-
5 ductions in the price of prescription drugs for Medicare
6 beneficiaries. The first reading of the bill shall be dis-
7 pensed with. All points of order against the bill and
8 against its consideration are waived. General debate shall
9 be confined to the bill and shall not exceed two hours, with
10 one hour equally divided and controlled by the chairman

1 and ranking minority member of the Committee on Com-
2 merce and one hour equally divided and controlled by the
3 chairman and ranking minority member of the Committee
4 on Ways and Means. After general debate the bill shall
5 be considered for amendment under the five-minute rule.
6 Each section of the bill shall be considered as read. At
7 the conclusion of consideration of the bill for amendment,
8 the Committee shall rise and report the bill to the House
9 with such amendments as may have been adopted. The
10 previous question shall be considered as ordered on the
11 bill and amendments thereto to final passage without in-
12 tervening motion, except one motion to recommit with or
13 without instructions.
