1 *Resolved*, That the requirement of clause 6(a) of rule
2 XIII for a two-thirds vote to consider a report from the
3 Committee on Rules on the same day it is presented to
4 the House is waived with respect to any resolution re-
5 ported on the legislative day of November 18, 1999, pro-
6 viding for consideration or disposition of any of the fol-
7 lowing measures:

1 (1) A bill or joint resolution making continuing
2 appropriations for the fiscal year 2000, any amend-
3 ment thereto, any conference report thereon, or any
4 amendment reported in disagreement from a con-
5 ference thereon.

6 (2) A bill or joint resolution making general ap-
7 propriations for the fiscal year ending September 30,
8 2000, any amendment thereto, any conference report
9 thereon, or any amendment reported in disagree-
10 ment from a conference thereon.
