3 Illinois is hereby authorized to introduce, and the House
4 may consider, a bill to amend section 6103 of title 5,
5 United States Code, to establish Presidents' Day in honor
6 of George Washington, Abraham Lincoln, and Franklin
7 Roosevelt.
