## **RESOLUTION**

Calling upon the President to take certain actions regarding imports of steel products from certain countries.

1 Resolved, That the House of Representatives calls upon the President— 3 (1) to immediately review, during the 10-day 4 period beginning on the date of the adoption of this 5 resolution, the entry into the customs territory of 6 the United States of all steel products that are the 7 product or manufacture of Australia, China, South 8 Africa, Ukraine, Indonesia, India, Japan, Russia, 9 South Korea, or Brazil;

- (2) if, after the 10-day period described in subparagraph (A), the President finds that the Government of Australia, China, South Africa, Ukraine, Indonesia, India, Japan, Russia, South Korea, or Brazil is not abiding by the spirit and letter of international trade agreements with respect to imports of steel products into the United States, to immediately impose a 1-year ban on the imports of all steel products that are the product or manufacture of the country with respect to which the finding is made;
  - (3) to establish a task force within the executive branch to closely monitor imports of steel products into the United States from other countries to determine whether or not international trade agreements are being violated; and
  - (4) not later than July 1, 2000, to report to the Congress on any other actions the President has taken, or intends to take, to ensure that all trading partners of the United States abide by the spirit and letter of international trade agreements with respect to imports of steel products into the United States.
