1 Resolved,

#### 2 SECTION 1. AMOUNTS FOR COMMITTEE EXPENSES.

For the expenses of the Committee on Rules (here-4 after in this resolution referred to as the "Committee"), 5 including the expenses of all staff salaries, there shall be 6 paid, out of the applicable accounts of the House of Rep-7 resentatives for committee salaries and expenses, not more 8 than \$5,069,424 for the One Hundred Sixth Congress. 9 SEC. 2. SESSION LIMITATIONS.

10 Of the amount specified in section 1—

(1) not more than \$2,488,522 shall be available
 for expenses incurred during the period beginning at
 noon on January 3, 1999, and ending immediately
 before noon on January 3, 2000; and

5 (2) not more than \$2,580,902 shall be available
6 for expenses incurred during the period beginning at
7 noon on January 3, 2000, and ending immediately
8 before noon on January 3, 2001.

## 9 SEC. 3. VOUCHERS.

Payments under this resolution shall be made on
vouchers authorized by the Committee, signed by the
Chairman of the Committee, and approved in the manner
directed by the Committee on House Administration.

### 14 SEC. 4. REGULATIONS.

15 Amounts made available under this resolution shall16 be expended in accordance with regulations prescribed by17 the Committee on House Administration.
