RESOLUTION

Honoring Future Business Leaders of America-Phi Beta
Lambda.

Whereas Future Business Leaders of America-Phi Beta Lambda (FBLA–PBL) is a nonprofit educational organization the first chapter of which was established in Johnson City, Tennessee, in 1942;

Whereas after years of expansion nationwide, FBLA–PBL has more than 250,000 members who are students in junior high schools, high schools, colleges, universities, vocational/technical schools, and private business schools;

Whereas FBLA–PBL is dedicated to bringing the business and education communities together in a positive working relationship through innovative leadership and career development programs;

Whereas members of FBLA–PBL perform community service activities and strive to build their understanding of the realities of the modern business world;

Whereas the divisions of FBLA–PBL include Future Business Leaders of America, which teaches high school students basic business and leadership principles, and Phi Beta Lambda, which helps university, college, vocational, technical, and business school students make the transition from school to work; and

Whereas many efforts are being made throughout the Nation to celebrate the week beginning February 7, 1999, as National Future Business Leaders of America-Phi Beta Lambda Week, and to use such week as an opportunity to inform and educate the people of the United States regarding the organization and its activities: Now, therefore, be it
