1 Resolved,

### 2 SECTION 1. AMOUNTS FOR COMMITTEE EXPENSES.

For the expenses of the Committee on Commerce (hereafter in this resolution referred to as the "Committee"), including the expenses of all staff salaries, there shall be paid, out of the applicable accounts of the House of Representatives for committee salaries and expenses, not more than \$15,537,415 for the One Hundred Sixth Congress.

#### 1 SEC. 2. SESSION LIMITATIONS.

2 Of the amount specified in section 1—

3 (1) not more than \$7,597,758 shall be available
4 for expenses incurred during the period beginning at
5 noon on January 3, 1999, and ending immediately
6 before noon on January 3, 2000; and

7 (2) not more than \$7,939,657 shall be available
8 for expenses incurred during the period beginning at
9 noon on January 3, 2000, and ending immediately
10 before noon on January 3, 2001.

#### 11 SEC. 3. VOUCHERS.

12 Payments under this resolution shall be made on 13 vouchers authorized by the Committee, signed by the 14 Chairman of the Committee, and approved in the manner 15 directed by the Committee on House Administration.

## 16 SEC. 4. REGULATIONS.

17 Amounts made available under this resolution shall18 be expended in accordance with regulations prescribed by19 the Committee on House Administration.
