- 2 SECTION 1. AMOUNTS FOR COMMITTEE EXPENSES.
- For the expenses of the Committee on Resources
- 4 (hereinafter in this resolution referred to as the "Commit-
- 5 tee"), including the expenses of all staff salaries, there
- 6 shall be paid, out of the applicable accounts of the House
- 7 of Representatives for committee salaries and expenses,
- 8 not more than \$11,270,338.00 for the One Hundred Sixth
- 9 Congress.

#### 1 SEC. 2. SESSION LIMITATIONS.

- 2 Of the amount specified in section 1—
- 3 (1) not more than \$5,530,746.00 shall be avail-
- 4 able for expenses incurred during the period begin-
- 5 ning at noon on January 3, 1999, and ending imme-
- 6 diately before noon on January 3, 2000; and
- 7 (2) not more than \$5,739,592.00 shall be avail-
- 8 able for expenses incurred during the period begin-
- 9 ning at noon on January 3, 2000, and ending imme-
- diately before noon on January 3, 2001.

### 11 SEC. 3. VOUCHERS.

- Payments under this resolution shall be made on
- 13 vouchers authorized by the Committee, signed by the
- 14 Chairman of the Committee, and approved in the manner
- 15 directed by the Committee on House Administration.

### 16 SEC. 4. REGULATIONS.

- 17 Amounts made available under this resolution shall
- 18 be expended in accordance with regulations prescribed by
- 19 the Committee on House Administration.
