joint resolution that is considered by each House of
 Congress under procedures that preclude amend ments; or

4 "(2) implements any trade agreement and that
5 is not subject to amendment;

6 shall be considered as passed or agreed to unless so deter-7 mined by a vote of not less than two-thirds of the Members8 voting.".
