Amending clause 5 of rule XXVI.

Mr. HANSEN (for himself, Mr. BERMAN, Mr. HASTERT, Mr. ARMEY, Mr. GEPHARDT, Mr. DELAY, and Mr. BONIOR) submitted the following resolution; which was considered and agreed to

RESOLUTION

Amending clause 5 of rule XXVI.

1 *Resolved*, That subparagraph (1) of clause 5(a) of
2 rule XXVI is amended—

3 (1) by inserting “(A)” before “A Member”; and

4 (2) by adding at the end the following new sub-
5 division:

6 “(B) A Member, Delegate, Resident Commissioner,
7 officer, or employee of the House may accept a gift (other
8 than cash or cash equivalent) that the Member, Delegate,
9 Resident Commissioner, officer, or employee reasonably
10 and in good faith believes to have a value of less than
11 \$50 and a cumulative value from one source during a cal-

1 endar year of less than \$100. A gift having a value of
2 less than \$10 does not count toward the \$100 annual
3 limit. Formal recordkeeping is not required by this sub-
4 division, but a Member, Delegate, Resident Commissioner,
5 officer, or employee of the House shall make a good faith
6 effort to comply with this subdivision.”.
