Mr. TORRICELLI introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To amend part Q of title I of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 to provide assistance for unincorporated neighborhood watch programs.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ASSISTANCE FOR UNINCORPORATED NEIGH-**
4 **BORHOOD WATCH PROGRAMS.**

5 (a) SHORT TITLE.—This Act maybe cited as the
6 “Neighborhood Watch Partnership Act of 1999”.

7 (b) IN GENERAL.—Section 1701(d) of title I of the
8 Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 (42
9 U.S.C. 3796dd(d)) is amended—

1 (1) in paragraph (10), by striking “and” at the
2 end;

3 (2) in paragraph (11), by striking the period at
4 the end and inserting “; and”; and

5 (3) by adding at the end the following:

6 “(12) provide assistance to unincorporated
7 neighborhood watch organizations approved by the
8 appropriate local police or sheriff’s department, in
9 an amount equal to not more than \$1950 per orga-
10 nization, for the purchase of citizen band radios,
11 street signs, magnetic signs, flashlights, and other
12 equipment relating to neighborhood watch patrols.”.

13 (c) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—Section
14 1001(a)(11) of title I of the Omnibus Crime Control and
15 Safe Streets Act of 1968 (42 U.S.C. 3793(a)(11)) is
16 amended—

17 (1) in subparagraph (A), by striking clause (vi)
18 and inserting the following:

19 “(vi) \$282,625,000 for fiscal year 2000.”; and

20 (2) in subparagraph (B) by inserting after
21 “(B)” the following: “Of amounts made available to
22 carry out part Q in each fiscal year \$14,625,000
23 shall be used to carry out section 1701(d)(12).”.
