## AN ACT

- To amend the Pacific Northwest Electric Power Planning and Conservation Act to provide for expanding the scope of the Independent Scientific Review Panel.
  - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

1	SECTION 1. REVIEW OF REIMBURSABLE PROJECTS, PRO-
2	GRAMS, AND MEASURES BY THE INDE-
3	PENDENT SCIENTIFIC REVIEW PANEL OF THE
4	PACIFIC NORTHWEST ELECTRIC POWER
5	PLANNING COUNCIL.
6	Section $4(h)(10)(D)$ of the Pacific Northwest Electric
7	Power Planning and Conservation Act (16 U.S.C.
8	839b(h)(10)(D)) is amended by striking clauses (vii) and
9	(viii) and inserting the following:
10	"(vii) REVIEW BY THE PANEL OF RE-
11	IMBURSABLE PROJECTS, PROGRAMS, AND
12	MEASURES.—
13	"(I) IN GENERAL.—With regard
14	to Columbia Basin fish and wildlife
15	projects, programs or measures pro-
16	posed in a Federal agency budget to
17	be reimbursed by BPA, or paid
18	through a direct funding agreement
19	with BPA, the panel shall annually—
20	"(aa) review such proposals;
21	"(bb) determine whether the
22	proposals are consistent with the
23	criteria stated in item (iv);
24	"(cc) make any rec-
25	ommendations that the Panel
26	considers appropriate to make

the project, program, or measure
meet the criteria stated in item
(iv); and
"(dd) transmit the rec-
ommendations to the Council no
later than April 1 of each year.
"(II) PUBLIC AVAILABILITY AND
COMMENT.—Determinations and rec-
ommendations made by the panel
under subclause (I) shall be available
to the public and shall be subject to
public comment as in item (v).
"(III) ROLE OF THE COUNCIL.—
The Council shall fully consider the
recommendations of the Panel when
making its final recommendations of
projects proposed by Federal agencies
and reimbursed by BPA, or paid
through a direct funding agreement
with BPA. The Council shall submit
its recommendations to the House and
Senate Committees on Appropriations
and relevant authorizing committees,
and the U.S. Army Corps of Engi-
neers, U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service,

1	Bureau of Reclamation, and the Bon-
2	neville Power Administration no later
3	than May 15 of each year. If the
4	Council does not incorporate a rec-
5	ommendation of the Panel in its rec-
6	ommendations, the Council shall ex-
7	plain in writing its reasons for not ac-
8	cepting Panel recommendations.
9	"(viii) Cost limitation.—The an-
10	nual cost of this provision shall not exceed
11	\$750,000 in 1997 dollars.".
