## A BILL

To provide for greater access to child care services for Federal employees.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. CHILD CARE SERVICES FOR FEDERAL EMPLOY-
- 4 EES.
- 5 (a) In General.—An Executive agency that pro-
- 6 vides or proposes to provide child care services for Federal
- 7 employees may use appropriated funds (otherwise avail-
- 8 able to such agency for salaries) to provide child care, in
- 9 a Federal or leased facility, or through contract, for em-
- 10 ployees of such agency.

- 1 (b) Affordability.—Amounts so provided with re-
- 2 spect to any such facility or contractor shall be applied
- 3 to improve the affordability of child care for lower income
- 4 Federal employees using or seeking to use the child care
- 5 services offered by such facility or contractor.
- 6 (c) REGULATIONS.—Not later than 180 days after
- 7 the date of enactment of this Act, the Office of Personnel
- 8 Management shall issue regulations necessary to carry out
- 9 this section.
- 10 (d) Definition.—In this section, the term "Execu-
- 11 tive agency" has the meaning given such term under sec-
- 12 tion 105 of title 5, United States Code, but does not in-
- 13 clude the General Accounting Office.
