3 SECTION 1. CONVEYANCE OF FACILITY.

The Secretary of Energy shall convey to the city of Bartlesville, Oklahoma, for no consideration, the approximately 15.644 acres of land comprising the former site of the National Institute of Petroleum Energy Research (including all improvements on the land) described as follows: All of block 1, Keeler's Second Addition, all of Block 2, Keeler's Fourth Addition, all of Blocks 9 and 10, Moun tain View Addition, and vacated Penn Avenue running
north and south between Block 9 and 10, Mountain View
Addition, all in the city of Bartlesville, Washington Coun ty, Oklahoma.
