Mr. FEINGOLD introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Environment and Public Works

A BILL

To phase out Federal funding of the Tennessee Valley Authority.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TENNESSEE VALLEY AUTHORITY.**

4 (a) DISCONTINUANCE OF APPROPRIATIONS.—Section
5 27 of the Tennessee Valley Authority Act of 1933 (16
6 U.S.C. 831z) is amended by inserting “for fiscal years
7 through fiscal year 2000” before the period.

8 (b) PLAN.—Not later than June 1, 1999, the Direc-
9 tor of the Office of Management and Budget shall develop
10 and submit a plan to Congress that—

1 (1) reviews the nonpower activities conducted
2 by the Tennessee Valley Authority using appro-
3 priated funds;

4 (2) determines whether the nonpower activities
5 performed by the Tennessee Valley Authority can be
6 adequately performed by other Federal agencies, and
7 if so, describes the resources needed by other agen-
8 cies to perform such activities;

9 (3) describes ongoing Federal interest in the
10 continuation of the nonpower activities currently
11 performed by the Tennessee Valley Authority; and

12 (4) recommends any legislation that may be ap-
13 propriate to carry out the objectives of this Act.

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
