- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

- 3 SECTION 1. ESTABLISHMENT OF NATIONAL CEMETERY.
- 4 (a) In General.—The Secretary of Veterans Affairs
- 5 shall establish, in accordance with chapter 24 of title 38,
- 6 United States Code, a national cemetery in the Miami,
- 7 Florida, metropolitan area to serve the needs of veterans
- 8 and their families.
- 9 (b) Report.—As soon as practicable after the date
- 10 of enactment of this Act, the Secretary shall submit to

- 1 Congress a report that sets forth a schedule for the estab-
- 2 lishment of the national cemetery under subsection (a)
- 3 and an estimate of the costs associated with such estab-

4 lishment.
