To amend section 40102(37) of title 49, United States Code, to modify the definition of the term "public aircraft" to provide for certain law enforcement and emergency response activities.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Law Enforcement Pub-
- 5 lic Aviation Reform Act of 1999".
- 6 SEC. 2. PUBLIC AIRCRAFT.
- 7 The flush sentence following subparagraph (B)(ii) of
- 8 section 40102(37) of title 49, United States Code, is

- 1 amended by striking "if the unit of government on whose
- 2 behalf the operation is conducted certifies to the Adminis-
- 3 trator of the Federal Aviation Administration that the op-
- 4 eration was necessary to respond to a significant and im-
- 5 minent threat to life or property (including natural re-
- 6 sources) and that no service by a private operator was rea-
- 7 sonably available to meet the threat" and inserting "if the
- 8 operation is conducted for law enforcement, search and
- 9 rescue, or responding to an imminent threat to life, prop-
- 10 erty, or natural resources".
