5 **TION SYSTEM.**

6 (a) TERMINATION REQUIRED.—The Secretary of the  
7 Navy shall terminate the operation of the Extremely Low  
8 Frequency Communication System of the Navy.

9 (b) MAINTENANCE OF INFRASTRUCTURE.—The Sec-  
10 retary shall maintain the infrastructure necessary for re-
