A BILL

To terminate the F/A–18 E/F aircraft program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TERMINATION OF THE F/A–18E/F AIRCRAFT**
4 **PROGRAM.**

5 (a) TERMINATION OF PROGRAM.—The Secretary of
6 Defense shall terminate the F/A–18 E/F aircraft pro-
7 gram.

8 (b) PAYMENT OF TERMINATION COSTS.—Funds
9 available for procurement and for research, development,
10 test, and evaluation that are available on or after the date
11 of the enactment of this Act for obligation for the F/A–

- 1 18 E/F aircraft program may be obligated for that pro-
- 2 gram only for payment of the costs associated with the
- 3 termination of the program.
