- 8 (b) Payment of Termination Costs.—Funds
- 9 available for procurement and for research, development,
- 10 test, and evaluation that are available on or after the date
- 11 of the enactment of this Act for obligation for the F/A-

- 1 18 E/F aircraft program may be obligated for that pro-
- 2 gram only for payment of the costs associated with the

3 termination of the program.
