- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. ANTI-DRUG MESSAGES ON INTERNET SITES.
- 4 Not later than 90 days after the date of enactment
- 5 of this Act, the Administrator of the National Aeronautics
- 6 and Space Administration, in consultation with the Direc-
- 7 tor of the Office of National Drug Control Policy, shall
- 8 place anti-drug messages on appropriate Internet sites

- 1 controlled by the National Aeronautics and Space Admin-
- 2 istration.
