(1) IN GENERAL.—The property referred to in subsection (a) is a parcel of National Forest land (including any improvements on the land) in Elko County, Nevada, known as "Jarbidge Cemetery", consisting of approximately 2 acres and described as the NE½4SW1¼4NW¼4 of Section 9 T 46 N, R 58 E, MDB&M.

(2) Survey.—

- (A) IN GENERAL.—The exact acreage and legal description of the property to be conveyed under subsection (a) shall be determined by a survey satisfactory to the Secretary.
- 14 (B) Cost.—As a condition of any convey-15 ance under this section, the County shall pay 16 the cost of the survey.
- 17 (c) Additional Terms and Conditions.—The
 18 Secretary may require such additional terms and condi19 tions with respect to the conveyance under subsection (a)
 20 as the Secretary considers appropriate to protect the inter21 ests of the United States.
