## A BILL

To amend the Marine Protection, Research, and Sanctuaries Act of 1972 to clarify the limitation on the dumping of dredged material in Long Island Sound.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Long Island Sound  
5       Protection Act”.

6       **SEC. 2. LONG ISLAND SOUND PROTECTION.**

7       Section 106 of the Marine Protection, Research, and  
8       Sanctuaries Act (33 U.S.C. 1416) is amended—

1           (1) by striking “(f) In” and inserting the fol-  
 2       lowing:

3       “(f) LONG ISLAND SOUND.—

4           “(1) IN GENERAL.—In”; and

5       (2) by adding at the end the following:

6       “(2) MULTIPLE PROJECTS.—

7           “(A) IN GENERAL.—Paragraph (1) shall  
 8       apply to a project described in paragraph (1)  
 9       if—

10           “(i) 1 or more projects of that type  
 11       produce, in the aggregate, dredged mate-  
 12       rial in excess of 25,000 cubic yards; and

13           “(ii)(I) the project or projects are car-  
 14       ried out in a proximate geographical area;  
 15       or

16           “(II) the aggregate quantity of  
 17       dredged material produced by the project  
 18       or projects is transported, for dumping  
 19       purposes, by the same barge.

20           “(B) REGULATIONS.—As soon as prac-  
 21       ticable, but not later than 60 days after the  
 22       date of enactment of this paragraph, the Ad-  
 23       ministrators shall promulgate regulations that  
 24       define the term ‘proximate geographical area’  
 25       for purposes of subparagraph (A)(i).

1           “(3) DESIGNATED SITE.—Not later than 2  
2       years after the date of enactment of this paragraph,  
3       the Administrator shall designate under section  
4       102(c) at least 1 site for the dumping of dredged  
5       material generated in the vicinity of Long Island  
6       Sound.

7           “(4) PROHIBITION ON DUMPING OF DREDGED  
8       MATERIAL.—Except at the site or sites designated  
9       under paragraph (3) (if the site or sites are located  
10      in Long Island Sound), no dredged material shall be  
11      dumped in Long Island Sound after the date on  
12      which the Administrator designates at least 1 site  
13      under paragraph (3).”.
