Mr. FEINGOLD (for himself, Mr. HARKIN, and Mr. WELLSTONE) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Armed Services

A BILL

To terminate production under the D5 submarine-launched ballistic missile program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TERMINATION OF D5 SUBMARINE-LAUNCHED**
4 **BALLISTIC MISSILE PROGRAM.**

5 (a) TERMINATION OF PROGRAM.—The Secretary of
6 Defense shall terminate production of D5 submarine bal-
7 listic missiles under the D5 submarine-launched ballistic
8 missile program.

9 (b) PAYMENT OF TERMINATION COSTS.—Funds
10 available on or after the date of the enactment of this Act

1 for obligation for the D5 submarine-launched ballistic mis-
2 sile program may be obligated for production under that
3 program only for payment of the costs associated with the
4 termination of production under this Act.

5 (c) INAPPLICABILITY TO MISSILES IN PRODUC-
6 TION.—Subsections (a) and (b) do not apply to missiles
7 in production on the date of the enactment of this Act.
